



Children's Social Skills Group

Group Description: Children will learn skills which improve socialization with adults and peers. Activities and games are used in a structured environment to give children opportunities to practice the healthy coping skills that are taught in group. The group leaders practice the concepts of strengthening the positives and learning from the negatives. Each week a structured routine will be followed; introductions, identifying and listing the rules, snack, skills training activities, points.

Sessions: The group will be open-ended and participants may join at any time. The duration of group participation varies between participants depending on their level of need and achievement of individual goals.

Population: Boys and girls 9 - 12 year olds

Time: Every Thursday from 4:00 – 5:00 pm
